IGHT IS ENOUGH" former child star Adam Rich has once again entered drug rehab - but this time it was his choice and he is vowing to get sober and stay sober.

"This was a huge decision for Adam," a source close to the trou-36-year-old told The ENQUIRER.

"He's been on extremely shaky ground, and constantly on the verge of relapsing. So he surrendered him-

self completely to a faith-based rehab.

"He knew he had gotten to the point where it's all or nothing.

"Adam told me, 'I got rid of my apartment, sold my car, and am living in this rehab facility.

"I did it because I wanted to reflect on life and re-create the person I used to be. I knew I needed to get in touch with my spiritual roots and find God on a

deeper level. I feared that if I relapsed again, it would be my final time."

Rich's life has been spinning out of control since "Eight Is Enough" went off the air in 1981. Four failed TV series followed.

In 1988, he underwent treatment for cocaine addiction, and the following year he nearly died

of a Valium overdose, which left him had gotten to the in a two-week coma.

> In 2001, pal Charlie Sheen forced a suicidal Rich into

rehab for the second time in three months. The next year he landed in jail on a DUI charge.

But Rich couldn't stop doing drugs . . . until now.

"He told me that he's never felt such peace as he's feeling in this faith-based rehab," said the close
