OBODY expects to have a heart attack, but "Jeopardy!" host Alex Trebek's recent medical emergency stunned him and those close to the star.

Trebek is not overweight, doesn't smoke, keeps himself in good shape and had no warning signs - so the attack came

as a huge surprise, said a source close to the 67-year-old star.

"It was like a lightening bolt. Alex watches his weight – but he now realizes he's going to have to work even harder to stay healthy."

The game show host was rushed by ambulance to Cedars-Sinai Medical Center on Dec. 10 after suffering excruciating chest pains.

Doctors determined Trebek had suffered a minor heart attack, but fortunately he did not require surgery. He was quickly stabilized and kept under observation before being released three days later.

"It was a wake-up call for Alex," a close source told The ENQUIRER.

Despite the searing pain, Alex remained calm throughout the ordeal, says another insider.
