The wall in the extravagant living room features a large portrait of Ann in a long gown—a gift to her mom Clara, who lived in the house until her death in 1981.

In the den is another large painting of Ann showing the gorgeous gams that made her famous. The room also boasts an ornate bar and a giant cabinet holding the numerous awards she's received. The stately Beverly Hills mansion

is legendary for the lavish Christmas parties Ann threw each year. Co-stars were always invited and the guest list included Hollywood's biggest names—Judy Garland, Fred Astaire, Gene Kelly, Lana Turner, Rita Hayworth, Carmen Miranda and Frank Sinatra.

The house, which cost \$50,000 when she bought it in 1940, is now worth about \$5 million. But Ann, now dating actor Morgan Woodward, 75, will never sell it.

"I think about it sometimes, but I can't let it go," she confides. "It holds too many memories. Besides, it's my friend."
