COURTENEY COX

Age-defying Courteney has amazingly smooth skin for a 44-year-old - but it's not due to Botox - any more. She's been there and done that. The former "Friends" star tried the popular anti-aging injections - and says she hated them. "I was miserable. I'm an actor - I've got to be able to move my face."



MARCIA CROSS

Pale-complexioned Marcia, 46, takes extra care of her skin by always wearing a hat while in the sun, but plastic surgeon Dr. Douglas M. Senderoff says she might have had Botox in her forehead and around her eyes. "The muscles in the top half of her face look completely relaxed," he notes. He adds that even when she's smiling, "there are no wrinkles around her eyes." But the New York expert, who has not treated the star, adds that Marcia seems to get just the right amount of Botox because she's still able to show facial expression.
