

CHERYL TIEGS' MARRIAGE #4 GOES BUST

CHERYL TIEGS' husband has had it with her wild, hard-partying lifestyle and has filed for divorce - just three years after they tied the knot.

Fed-up yoga instructor Rod Stryker, 43, is asking the court to award him custody of their year-old sons Jaden and Theo, test-tube babies who were carried by a surrogate mom.

"Mr. Stryker is asking for primary custody because he believes it's in the best interest of the children," his attorney Peggy Garrity tells GLOBE.

Cheryl's fourth husband filed for divorce after pleading with

the 54-year-old covergirl to dump her unsavory pals and quit her all-night partying, say sources.

"Cheryl got very involved with a strange group of people and would stay out all night partying with them," confides a pal. "They admire her because she used to be a top model, and she basks in the attention they give her."

Finally, Rod decided to tag along during one of her party sprees to find out what she found so fascinating. "He hit the roof when he saw what was going on," the pal reveals. "He told her, 'I won't tolerate this!'"

He told Cheryl he wanted her home with him and the kids, but she refused, a source says. "She told him it's her life to do with what she wants," the pal explains.

Meanwhile, Enid Gill and her daughter Sylvia Theus, originally hired as nannies for the twins, quit after three days, charging the model wasn't interested in the babies.

Now, Stryker, who's still living in the same house with Cheryl and the twins, is asking for primary custody.

"Mr. Stryker has not yet moved out because he feels it's better for the twins that he stay close," says his attorney. "He only cares about what's best for the babies."
