STARSKY & Hutch star David Soul is a deadbeat dad, says his ex-wife, and owes \$65,000 in court-ordered child support.

Soul, who played good-guy cop Hutch in the hit '70s series, moved to England in 1995 – turning his back on his ex-wife Patti and their three sons, Brendan, 18, Timothy, 17, and Andrew, 16.

"It breaks my heart," Patti confides.
"Brendan dropped out of school to
work, just to have a little spending
money. And now the other boys want
to do the same. It's been so hard on
them to grow up without a father."

After the couple's bitter divorce in 1986, Patti and her young sons left Los Angeles for Idaho. They live in a modest home in rural Post Falls.


Soul, who has three other children from other marriages, made regular child support payments to Patti until 1996, when they just stopped. It was at a time, she says, that "his boys needed it the most."

Patti, 49, says she was forced to give up her 25-year hobby of raising horses, all extra activities for the kids and even their health insurance. Right now, she claims she can't even afford to take her ex to court.

Meanwhile, the 57-year-old actor/ singer, who had No.1 hits in the '70s, is doing well in London, where he lives with longtime girlfriend Alexa Hamilton. He's acting, directing and producing stage shows and singing in nightclubs. He'll also appear on TV in the BBC hospital drama Holby City this spring.

"But Soul is delinquent on courtordered child support to the tune of nearly \$65,000," declares Patti's attorney Robert Garcin.
