Natalie and Emily were dropped off in the morning of October 10 at the Beverly Hills offices of plastic surgeon Dr. Harry Glassman, husband of actress Victoria Principal. He usually charges about \$12,000 for full body liposuction, while a tummy tuck can

The source said she had liposuction on her arms, back, legs, stomach and hips. Emily, in a hooded top, left at 5.30pm. Both were taken by town car to The Serenity House in Santa Monica for four days of pampered recovery at a cost of \$4,000 each.

Natalie has two sons, age one and five, with actor Adrian Pasdar, who will soon appear as Eva Longoria's love interest in *Desperate Housewives*.

"Natalie had tried to diet and exercise but she just couldn't shed the extra pounds," said the

insider. "I'm sure the thought of Adrian playing the lover of toned and slender Eva Longoria also had a part in her deciding on liposuction."
