

# It's Over... SINATRA JR.'S MARRIAGE FINALLY CRASHES

**F**RANK SINATRA JR.'s on-again, off-again marriage to attorney Cynthia McMurrey is off again - this time for good, say sources.

McMurrey has packed up her belongings and two daughters, left Sinatra's L.A. home and moved back to her native Houston, where she oversees a thriving law practice. "Cynthia is gone for good," confides a friend of the troubled couple. "This time, she's not coming back."

The turbulent marriage - his first, her fifth - crumbled three months short of its third anniversary, and pals are surprised it lasted that long.

After barely a year, Ol' Blue Eyes' 55-year-old son was griping about his wife's spending and constant globe-trotting for her work.

Then, as GLOBE reported last August, the singer slapped McMurrey, 48, with divorce

papers, offering not a penny of alimony. Just one month later, we revealed he'd reconciled with her and rescinded the court papers.

But the relationship was still shaky, say sources, and McMurrey grew more and more peeved with Sinatra.

"Frank drove Cynthia nuts with his habits," says an insider. "He ate lunch every day at

the same dell in Beverly Hills, sitting there with a grumpy look on his face, lecturing her instead of talking to her.

"And Frank would constantly play his father's music at home, until she'd snap. 'No offense, but I've got to hear the Beatles once in a while, too!' Cynthia wanted to go to the movies and for long, romantic walks. But he

wanted to be out and about without her."

McMurrey tried to forge a happy family that included her daughters Victoria, 12, and Brittany, 14, and Frank Jr.'s 14-year-old son Frank. But her hubby never grew into the daddy role, say sources.

And an insider notes that Sinatra's famous sisters Tina and Nancy, who believed McMurrey was a gold digger, always stuck up for him, saying, "Our own daddy was never around, so how could he learn to be a dad himself?"

Now, McMurrey is thrilled to be free of Frank and his eccentricities, and she no longer has to worry about being treated like a second-class citizen by the other Sinatras.

"Frank is in Scandinavia touring with his band," says a source, "and Cynthia is relieved he's far away."
