Petite size 2, the former "Spin City" beauty has always been usually full-breasted. But when asked whether she's ever had plastic surgery, the 45-year-old spot responded: "It's all me. That you see is what you get."

**DR. YOUN:** "This is a tough call. Heather may have had small implants to give her a lift – or she may simply wear push-up bras to make her breasts look fuller. Due to their extremely natural shape, I'd say her breasts are real. She's one of a handful of women blessed with a slim body and ample breast size."



## JESSICA SIMPSON

The voluptuous beauty, 26, is as well known for her figure as she is for her singing and acting – and there has been endless speculation about whether her most pronounced assets are real or enhanced.

**DR. YOUN:** "No one really knows for sure if Jessica has had implants, and she has often denied it. But in my opinion the size of her breasts, along with their roundness at the top and sides, signify augmentation."

## JENNIFER ANISTON

When the 38-year-old star admitted she'd undergone surgery to repair a deviated septum earlier this year, she set insiders buzzing about whether she'd enhanced her breasts at the same time. But the former "Friends" beauty is dressed by Hollywood's top stylists, who are geniuses at fitting their clients with bras that give breasts a flattering boost.

**DR. YOUN:** "I doubt very much that Jennifer has had a breast augmentation. From what I can see, she's walking around with a very beautiful set of natural breasts."
