

HUNTER TYLO AFTER SON, 19,

“I WANT to be with him! I want my boy! Oh my God! How could this have happened?”

“The Bold and the Beautiful” star Hunter Tylo poured out her grief after learning her 19-year-old son was found dead in her swimming pool.

The distraught actress was so traumatized she was put in a 72-hour psychiatric lockdown after kicking at and cracking the window of a police car rushing her to a Los Angeles hospital, The ENQUIRER has learned.

MICHAEL TYLO WAS FOUND fully clothed in the pool at Hunter’s Las Vegas-area home just before midnight Oct. 18. He is believed to have suffered a seizure before falling into the water, and the Clark County (Nev.) coroner’s office listed his death as an accidental drowning.

“Hunter was absolutely devastated after receiving the phone call that is every parent’s nightmare,” a family friend told The ENQUIRER.

“She practically collapsed. She was sobbing. Someone got through to her therapist, who insisted Hunter admit herself to a hospital.

“When Hunter refused, the therapist did what he felt was a lifesaving measure – he called the police.”

In the early morning hours of Oct. 19, the police sent a team to pick up the actress at her Los Angeles home. But the shattered mom was agitated – and kicked at the windows of the police car, said the friend.

“It was absolutely heartbreaking.

“HUNTER’S THERAPIST and her boyfriend accompanied her to the emergency room.

“She kept screaming for her boy and asking God how it could have happened.”

Hunter’s boyfriend desperately tried to console her, but there was nothing anyone could do to ease such terrible emotional pain.

At one point, according to the friend, Hunter “was completely

berserk, and kept screaming at the police and the emergency room staff. ‘--- you! Leave me the --- alone!’ she kept yelling. ‘I can’t ---ing believe this!’

“It took 12 medical per-

sonnel to restrain her.

“Doctors medicated her, and after a few minutes, she calmed down.

“A day later, she was taken to Thaliens, the psychiatric ward at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. She could not stop crying.”

In the exclusive Henderson, Nev. community where Michael died a sign was posted at Tyler’s home that read: “We Love Mickey.”
