


“GREY’S ANATOMY” star Katherine Heigl and her singer hubby Josh Kelley are adopting a baby, The ENQUIRER has learned exclusively.

The 29-year-old Emmy-winning actress decided she didn’t want to get “Knocked Up” – and the couple expects to start their family with a child from Korea within a year, sources say.

Welcoming a baby from Korea holds special meaning for Katherine because her older sister Meg was adopted from that country.

“Meg has had a profound impact on Katherine’s life, which is why she and Josh are trying to adopt a Korean child,” a friend close to the couple revealed to The ENQUIRER.

“They’ve chosen an adoption agency and have started filing the necessary paperwork.

option for them right now. Katherine’s got several movie projects in the pipeline and a pregnancy would bring her career to a halt for a while,” said the friend.

“Besides, she still has plenty of time to have her own children if she chooses.”

Singer-songwriter Josh, 28, recently said the couple was focusing on their careers, not starting a family.

But Katherine – who plays Dr. Isobel “Izzie” Stevens in ABC’s Emmy-winning medical series – has revealed the graphic birthing scene in her hit comedy “Knocked Up” dampened her desire to have her own children, but intensified her will to adopt.

“I’ve always planned to adopt,” the “27 Dresses” star said. “I’m done with the whole idea of having my own children. It doesn’t seem like any fun. I don’t think it’s necessary to go through all of that.”

around her as she gave birth to beautiful twin girls Harper and Finley.

Before the joyous delivery, there were some anxious moments as doctors advised the 40-year-old mom to rest. “Lisa stayed in bed for three weeks before the twins were due,” divulged a source.

Her husband, musician Michael Lockwood, 47, waited on her hand and foot.

Upbeat Michael assured his

wife that the day of the births was “going to be a beautiful day!” He was right.

Doctors moved up the planned Caesarean delivery of the nonidentical twins by two weeks – to Oct. 7.

A devoted Michael was by Lisa Marie’s side throughout the procedure at Los Robles Hospital & Medical Center in Thousand Oaks, Calif.

“He held Lisa’s hand, stroked her head and whispered words of love and encouragement,” said the insider.

“He said, ‘This is the happiest day of my life, honey, and it’s all because of you.’ Michael cut the umbilical cords.”

Priscilla was there, happily

watching her granddaughters come into the world. Also there to share the joy were Lisa’s daughter Riley, 19, a model, and son Benjamin, 16, her children with ex-husband Danny Keough.

The twins, both healthy, arrived at 2:46 p.m., weighing 5 pounds, 15 ounces and 5 pounds, 2 ounces.

Lisa honored both her father and Priscilla by naming them Harper Vivienne Ann and Finley Aaron Love. Ann is Priscilla’s middle name and Aaron is Elvis’ middle name.

“Harper looks like Lisa Marie,” revealed the insider, “and Finley looks like her dad.”
