Star's wild night on remote island with male pals

HERE'S where the boys are! Oscar-winning actor Kevin Spacey spent his summer vacation partying with a bevy of hot guys on an island off the Croatian coast.

"Usually Kevin is very discreet when it comes to his social life, but this time, he totally let go," an insider told *The ENQUIRER*.

The party started after the "Usual Suspects" star, 49, attended the Sarajevo Film Festival in late August. He headed to Dubrovnik where he hosted a festival bash and was photographed smoking what looked like a hand-rolled marijuana cigarette with a male pal.

But it was Spacey's soused spree with a gang of guys on the island of Hvar that has jump-started longtime speculation about the never-married star's sexual orientation.

"KEVIN REALLY CUT LOOSE WHILE partying in Hvar," according to another source. "While he was at a club there, Kevin - fueled by plenty of drinking - pulled down the pants of a male friend and proceeded to slap his buddy's behind like it was a bongo drum.

"It was shocking to see Kevin publicly grope a man lying across his lap. It was 'Boys Gone Wild!'"
