
BUT THE "SCREAM" STAR'S FLIRTING came to a screeching halt when Matthew Perry tapped him on the shoulder, said the eyewitness.

"I think career problems are also pulling them in different directions - and they're spending less quality time together."

"Courteney and David love each other, but maybe they're beginning to realize that simply loving someone isn't enough to keep a marriage together. In the past, they've always managed to get through their problems, but this time divorce could be inevitable."
