

**L**INDSAY LOHAN is throwing a fit in rehab – and staffers fear her problems are beyond addiction and that she may have a chemical imbalance.

The “Mean Girls” star is clashing with counselors and butting heads with staff – and insiders say it is likely that she’ll return to her hard-partying ways as soon as she gets out.

“She’s acting like a spoiled brat!” declared a source close to the 20-year-old party animal.

“Some staff members believe that in addition to her addictions, she could also be suffering from a bipolar disorder.

“When she came in, she gave a brilliant performance as a tortured young star who wants to mend her ways.

“But she’s still in touch with all her friends, and she says the doctors and staff are all bull---!

“I think she believes that there’s nothing wrong with her and that she has no intention of sticking to any program once she gets out.”

Lindsay is fortunate to be in a topnotch treatment facility – the Wonderland Center in Los Angeles.

Insiders say the sneaky star will “act her way” through the program, but the experts are already wise to her.

“It’s not surprising she’s bucking the staff,” an insider told *The ENQUIRER*. “Prior to getting in to rehab, Lindsay had been making a show of going to Alcoholics Anonymous, but it was all a show.

“The regular members knew she was lying about her sobriety – and they even suspected she sometimes showed up high!”

The actress was admitted to the clinic Jan. 17 to beat her addiction to pain pills, cocaine and alcohol.

After repeated attempts to convince her she needed help, her mother Dina tried tough love, disclosed the close source.

“She convinced Lindsay’s friends to freeze her out by refusing to answer her calls or reply to her text messages. Everyone was in on it, including her hairdresser Andy LeCompte, fashion stylist Nate Newell – and even her 13-year-old sister Ali.

Finally, little Ali broke the wall of silence, and answered her sister’s call in tears – begging her to go to rehab.
