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## Pop docs say interview confirms party girl's despair

HOLLYWOOD is destroying Lindsay Lohan! Statements the "Mean Girls" star made in a recent interview are a clear sign that she's in trouble, say experts. "Lindsay is a lost child who could end up in a dark room clutching a bottle of booze," warned therapist and author Dr. Susan Forward. Forward, who recently did a brief stint in rehab, said in an "Allure" magazine interview that Lindsay should be able to help her family while her parents' marriage disintegrated around her.

"That's just in me, to keep everyone around me happy," she said.

Psychologist Dr. Jean Cirillo told The ENQUIRER: "Lindsay is taking too much responsibility for other people. It's a manifestation of her childhood trauma—being a parental child—which she's carried into her adulthood." Dr. Forward added: "All the clubbing and partying is Lindsay looking for her lost childhood. She's depressed and self-medicating to avoid her depression."

Lindsay, 20, also told "Allure": "I don't know that

I'm necessarily an addict," adding: "I always said I would die before I went to rehab."

Dr. Forward told The ENQUIRER: "I think she is an addict in total denial. In my opinion, she needs to be in a lockdown rehab facility without access to a computer, telephone or other distractions. That will make her face herself. But as long as she's in Hollywood, where people reinforce each other's pathology, she's never going to get better."
