MARY-KATE'S MYSTERY SCAR

■ *The truth about the cut on her wrist*

MARY-KATE OLSEN has a mystery cut on her wrist! A shocking photo uncovered by The ENQUIRER shows a vertical scar on her right forearm. Mary-Kate is left-handed.

Mary-Kate's spokesman Michael Pagnotta told The ENQUIRER the scar was due to "a fall" she had taken in the past.

"She fell and cut her chin at the same time," said Pagnotta, who provided no other details as to when the accident occurred or where it took place.

But a top doctor who examined the photo for The ENQUIRER said it was "virtually impossible" that the scar is the result of a fall.

"A straight and precise scar like the one photographed on her forearm could conceivably be

caused by a fall — but only if she fell directly on a knife that was perfectly placed," Dr. Jerome Litt, clinical assistant professor of dermatology at Case Western Reserve University, told The ENQUIRER.

"Otherwise it is virtually impossible to wind up with such a straight, surgical-looking wound unless you had surgery.

"Even falling on scissors wouldn't produce such a wound. A scissors wound would be more of a gouge."

And Dr. Jack Thomas, head of family practice at Long Beach Medical Center in Southern California, told The ENQUIRER:

"To me, this injury does not look as if it occurred as a result of a fall. In my opinion, this injury appears to be a linear laceration, possibly
