CHARGE:**

HIP-HOP QUEEN KEEPS DEAD MAN ON ICE!

THE body of the man who claimed to be Mary J. Blige's father has been laying on a morgue slab for more than a month because the hip-hop queen refuses to give the OK for him to be buried, his girlfriend charges.

Blige and her sister LaTonya deny that Marvin E. Williams is their dad and won't sign the next-of-kin release forms needed before his remains can be interred in a St. Louis, Mo., cemetery, the girlfriend says.

"Mary doesn't give a damn about Marvin," Felise Hutton, Williams live-in lover, tells GLOBE. "But he told me he was her dad and all I'm asking from her is the signature that will allow him a burial."

Officials with the medical examiner's office have been trying to get a release for the body since Williams died at age 46 of a massive heart attack July 19.

Although she doesn't have any proof to back up her claim, Hutton also told the coroner that Williams was the singer's dad.

"We were told that Williams is Mary J. Blige's father, and we did contact her," Jim Sofik, supervisor at the coroner's office, tells GLOBE. "But Blige denied that she's his daughter and, as no other family members are willing to

come forward, Williams' body is still here."

Blige's attorney Ronald E. Sweeney tells GLOBE the claims that Williams is the singer's dad are "false."

But Hutton insists that Blige, whose hits include What's the 411 and Share My World, and LaTonya ARE Williams' daughters, adding that she thinks they're bitter because he walked out on them when they were little.

"Marvin was 16 years old when Mary was born, and didn't raise her," Hutton claims. "I think Mary and LaTonya are holding a grudge against him. They say he abandoned them as children. But they're grown up now. It's time for them to forgive him."

Hutton says Williams never asked Blige for money when he was alive, and she's not asking for a handout now. All she's asking, says Hutton, is that Mary do the right thing and allow Williams to be buried.

"Marvin loved Mary and LaTonya very much," says Hutton. "For Mary to allow his body to lie at the coroner's office day after day is heartbreaking." — ROBIN MIZRAHI
