

JACK'S EX IN BLOODY BRAWL WITH BEAU

AS Jack Nicholson's children watched in horror, a bloody fight erupted between their mom, Rebecca Broussard, and her boyfriend - ending with cops dragging the boyfriend to a mental facility.

The ENQUIRER learned exclusively that what was supposed to be a happy family dinner in Santa Monica exploded in violence after Rebecca invited two young male friends to join their group.

"The fight was so violent - thankfully the police came quickly," said an eyewitness at Benihana's restaurant.

Sources say the blame falls directly on 43-year-old Rebecca's hot-head boyfriend Michael Matosek, who's been hitting her on and off

for years. Rebecca had organized the dinner with Michael and her two children by Nicholson - Lorraine, 16, and 14-year-old Raymond.

But all hell broke loose when Rebecca ran into two young brothers she knew.

Michael, 39, flew into an insane rage, say sources.

"The two men, in their early 20s, came by the table, and Matosek jumped up and screamed at them: 'You're not invited to our party!'" divulged a source.

"The boys were shocked. They approached Rebecca's table only because she asked them to.

"Plus, these guys were very slight, and Matosek

has a huge football player-type body.

"He grabbed the brothers by their throats, one with each hand, and pushed them out of the restaurant. On the way out, they knocked over a toddler in a high-chair.

"Rebecca ran after Michael and the guys, and Lorraine and Raymond also followed. Outside, Rebecca hit Matosek so hard his eye started bleeding."

After police arrived they "handcuffed Matosek and took him away.

"The young men won't press charges. They don't want to hurt Rebecca," said the source.

The Santa Monica Police Department confirmed that Matosek was arrested and taken to a mental facility for a 72-hour evaluation.

Asked by The ENQUIRER about the embarrassing brawl, Rebecca was reluctant to talk. "I can't go there," she said.

"I have no response. I was just standing there."
