

HOLY Hollywood! Charlene Tilton is gearing up to star in her dream movie project – playing super-evangelist Tammy Faye Messner.

The former “Dallas” sexpot was a longtime friend of Tammy Faye, who died in July 2007 after a decade-long battle with colon cancer. The two worked closely on writing an accurate account of Tammy Faye’s life.

“Tammy gave me her blessing to turn her life into a movie,” Charlene, 49, told The ENQUIRER in an

exclusive interview. “She was one of the most beautiful people I have ever known. She was totally forgiving and non-judgmental – and she deserves to be remembered as she was, a true Christian who loved all mankind.

“The script is nearing completion, and production companies are already showing a great deal of interest.

“In about three months a deal should be in place to turn Tammy’s life into a fascinating biopic. This project is the dream coming true for me,

and playing Tammy is a role I hold close to my heart.”

Charlene, who’s been married and divorced twice, will co-write, co-produce and star in the movie.

Tammy Faye, who started as a Christian singer, rocketed to fame when she and then-husband Jim Bakker started together on the now-defunct Christian PTL Network. She quickly became a household name and face – known for

her heavy makeup and mascara running down her cheeks when she cried.

At the height of its popularity, PTL raked in more than \$125 million annually. Eventually, the couple’s empire collapsed in scandal and Jim ended up in prison. She later divorced him and married Roe Messner.
