Reid started in showbiz at age 6, and shot to fame after the teen flick American Pie hit the screen in 1999.

"When I first met her a couple of years ago, I thought she was the prettiest thing," another pal tells GLOBE. "Now, her arms and legs are like toothpicks and she's always yanking on her pants to keep

them from falling down.
