'Housewife' skips bash, gives cast silent treatment

TERI HATCHER was so upset over being "slighted" on an invitation to "Desperate Housewives" show creator/Executive Producer Marc Cherry's 46th birthday party, she refused to attend the event.

And now she's resorted to giving her boss and her "Desperate Housewives" cast mates the silent treatment.

"Teri feels like an outcast on the show - and is rebelling," an insider told *The ENQUIRER*.

"SHE COMES TO THE SET, GOES straight to her trailer and only comes out when it's time to shoot her scenes.

"She doesn't utter a word to anyone - unless the cameras are rolling and she has to say her lines."
