Tracey Gold terrified of going to jail

GROWING Pains" star Tracey Gold is terrified of going to jail and having her family torn apart following her arrest for drunk driving that caused a horrific car crash and injured her husband and two of their three kids, say sources. "Tracey is completely traumatized by what happened."

"It's brought to light deep-rooted problems she needs to deal with," a source close to the 35-year-old actress told The ENQUIRER.

WORRIED TO DEATH

"Now she's worried to death that her family will be torn apart and that she might have to serve prison time."

Just before midnight on September 3, Tracey was at the wheel of her GMC Yukon in Ventura County near Los Angeles when she veered off the highway, causing her car to roll down an embankment.

Tracey wasn't hurt, but her husband, 39-year-old Roby Marshall, injured his neck. The couple's son Sage, 7, suffered a broken collarbone and laceration on his forehead, their son Aidan, 5, a few minor cuts

and 4-month-old Aidan wasn't hurt.

ANOREXIA BATTLE

The former child star, who played Carol Seaver in "Growing Pains" from 1985 to 1992, is well known for her successful battle against anorexia.

But that doesn't mean her

problems are behind her.

"She has the stress of three young children and worrying about the family finances," a friend of the actress told The ENQUIRER. "Roby lost his mother as a teenager, and soon he'll lose his father too."

In 1984, Marshall's father hired a hit man who

killed his mother and he's now awaiting execution in New Jersey.

Tracey's friend said she's seen signs of strain in the actress' marriage but the former child star "really wants to make it work."

"And she's desperate to get her career on track,

but she just isn't offered a lot of parts."

Following her arrest, Tracey was booked at Ventura County Jail, outside Los Angeles, and was released after posting \$50,000 bail. She's sched-

uled to appear in court on October 19.

"Now, Tracey's scared that she'll have to serve prison time," said the close source.

"She told me, 'If they separate me from my children, I just couldn't survive. The boys need me. Doesn't anyone understand that?'"

Tracey's attorney Blair Berk told The ENQUIRER, "They arrested Tracey on suspicion of DUI, but she hasn't been formally charged."

"They are still waiting for the results of the blood tests, and the case has been sent back to be re-investigated."
